



Digital Imaging Compatability Guide

We prefer PDF (Portable Document Format) files, set for the press optimized settings. Bleed should be set to .125". We will also accept files in their native file format, accompanied by all used fonts in your publication and the original files of all linked/imported pictures or graphics. Also, we need an accurate hard copy proof with any spot colors clearly identified. This gives us the best chance of eliminating any problems that may hold up output of your job.

Portable Formats

.pdf (written to press settings) **.eps** **.tif**

Due to restrictions in quality, we accept but do not recommend .jpg or .gif files.

Image Capture

We offer full scanning services including high quality, full color image capture, or high speed black and white capture for document building. If you plan to supply us scanned images, we recommend the following settings:

Line art : 1200 dpi (black and white images with no screens or shades of grey)

Greyscale/Full Color Images: 300 dpi

The default for most scanners or digital cameras is the RGB color mode. RGB can be accepted but we need to convert them to CMYK at the standard desktop charge.
